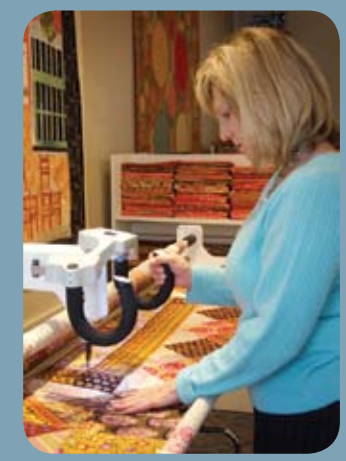

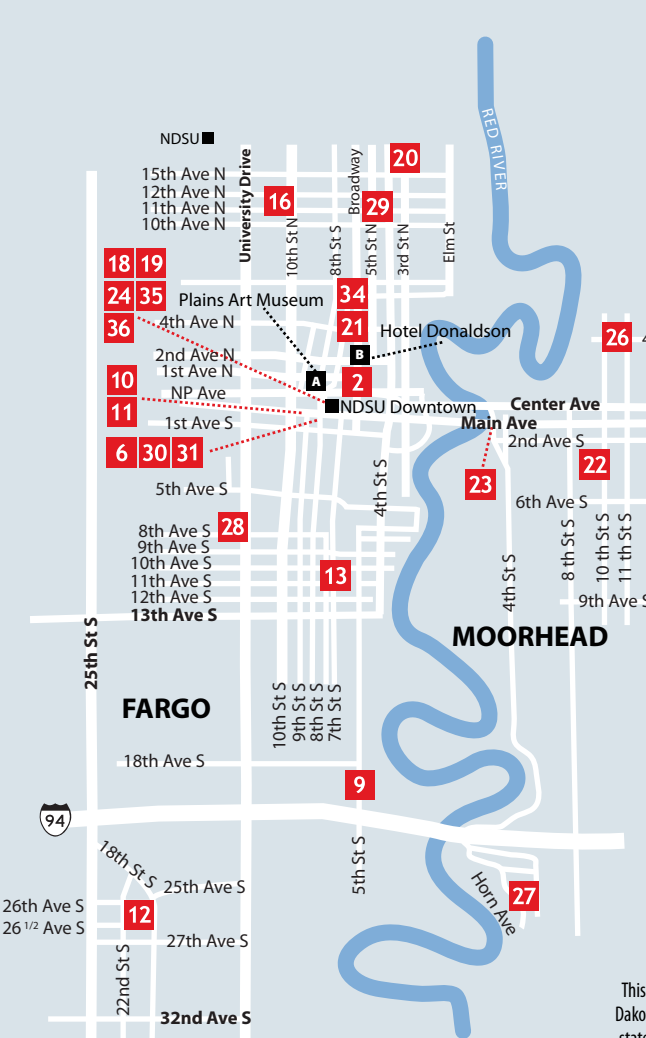

3: Directions: South on MN Highway 75 to Comstock, turn west on Clay Co. Rd. 2 and go about 1 mile to Clay Co. Rd. 59 (gravel), turn north, go 1 mile. Watch for sign on west side of the road. Entry road about 1 mile long.

30: Directions: North on Broadway, Left on 90th Ave N, Right on 15th St, North exactly 2 1/2 miles
